GLC COUNCIL NEWS

We are blessed and thankful for the generous giving as we reach mid-year.

Operating Fund giving to the end of May are \$79,460.

This leaves us \$16,879 below budget to May 31, 2024 and \$7,176. below actual giving to May 31, 2023.

There is an ongoing shift in giving from operations to designated charitable funds. In order for us to not fall further behind in our budget goal we respectfully request you consider your giving to operational funds for the next few months if possible.




