Johann Sebastian Bach is often regarded as one of the greatest composers of all time. Bach always gave thanks and credit to his Lord. The pages of his philharmonic compositions could have been only credited by him but he always shared the credit and gave thanks to God for his achievements. Bach ended every one of his free-handed compositions with the three letters INS. In Latin, this means, "In the name of Christ." In other pieces Bach began his musical score with the letters JJ, meaning "Jesus, help," and then concluded his composing with the letters SDG which means in the Latin "To God be the glory." "Solo Deo Gloria"

It seems that Bach was thankful for the music he created, but maybe, part of it was to first ask for help as he started. That is why we should be in prayer everyday. Asking & praising may be the key to joy and peace which will then lead us to be thankful in all circumstances.

I know that whatever circumstances that I have faced in my life, I always had something to be thankful for. Our hardships may not compare to others however, facing illness, failed relationships, family members dying of cancer, rejection by people who you thought were your friends, are all something that many have faced including myself. No matter the situation there is still something to be thankful for. I know that Jesus is going to help me through future circumstances and I know I can already give thanks to Jesus for the future, just as Johann Sebastian Bach had done. Thanksgiving will always be a time for us to reflect on what we can be thankful for. Most of us, I hope, will give thanks for all the good food we might enjoy but, will we go further and be thankful for the other Blessings? I am thankful for our church and our faith in Jesus Christ. We just had our Recognition Sunday and upon reading through our list of Volunteers and groups makes me appreciate the work and dedication that people have given with their time and resources. The key to a healthy church, a healthy faith, a healthy family life is to be thankful and to be thankful for all circumstances. Solo Deo Gloria!



Lord, it's difficult to find the words to express my gratitude for all the ways You have blessed my life.


As I prepare for this new month, I know that I cannot do it without You. But Your love and strength empower me.

I will keep my eyes focused on You. In Jesus name I pray, Amen!











THANKSGIVING MAZE
